


Gap of needs vs funding received (2023)







#### Needs


- •High stunting rate in Central Sulawesi
  (29.7%) in 2021 (source: Ministry of State Secretariat of the Republic of Indonesia, 2021)
- •Needs of affordable protein to increase nutrition
- •High market demand of egg not only in Central Sulawesi, but also surrounding provinces including Kalimantan
- •Increasing productive activities and decent job

One of social enterprise units to encourage recovery phase in Central Sulawesi and maintain organizational sustainability




